ACCESSION BY BAHRAIN

Sir,

I have the honour, upon instructions from the Secretary-General, to inform you that, on 4 May 1973, the instruments of accession by the Government of Bahrain to the Convention on Road Traffic, and to the Convention on Road Signs and Signals both done at Vienna on 8 November 1968, were deposited with the Secretary-General.

On depositing the above-mentioned instruments, the Government of Bahrain notified the Secretary-General, with reference to paragraph 4 of article 45 of the Convention on Road Traffic, that it had selected the distinguishing sign "BRN" for display in international traffic on vehicles registered by it, and in accordance with article 46(2) of the Convention on Road Signs and Signals, that it has also selected the model Aa as a danger warning sign and the model B, 2b as a stop sign.
