EXTENSION TO HONG KONG
(UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND)

Sir,

I have the honour, upon instructions from the Secretary-General, to refer to the accession by the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, on 24 September 1975, to the Convention on the Recognition and Enforcement of Foreign Arbitral Awards done at New York on 10 June 1958 (see letter C.N.261.1975.TREATIES-8 of 1 October 1975).

In this connexion, I wish to inform you that, in a notification received by the Secretary-General on 21 January 1977, the Government of the United Kingdom, in accordance with article X, paragraph 2, of the Convention, declared that it shall extend to Hong Kong. This extension, pursuant to the above-mentioned article, shall take effect as from the ninetieth day after the day of the receipt by the Secretary-General of the said notification, that is to say on 21 April 1977.
