CONVENTION ON ROAD TRAFFIC
DONE AT VIENNA ON 8 NOVEMBER 1968

ACCESSION BY KUWAIT

Sir,

I have the honour, upon instructions from the Secretary-General, to inform you that, on 14 March 1980, the instrument of accession by the Government of Kuwait to the Convention on Road Traffic, done at Vienna on 8 November 1968, was deposited with the Secretary-General.

The instrument of accession is accompanied by the following understanding:

"It is the understanding of the State of Kuwait that its accession to the said Convention does not imply recognition of Israel, or accepting any obligation towards it emanating from the provisions of the said Convention."

The Government of Kuwait, in accordance with the provisions of article 45(4) of the Convention, notified the Secretary-General that it has chosen the distinguishing sign "KWT" for display in international traffic on vehicles registered by it.

In accordance with article 47(2), the Convention will enter into force for Kuwait twelve months after the date of deposit of its instrument of accession, that is to say, on 14 March 1981.
