CONCLUDED AT GENEVA ON 14 NOVEMBER 1975

ENTRY INTO FORCE OF AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF THE  
FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY TO ANNEXES 1 AND 6 TO THE CONVENTION

Sir,

I have the honour, upon instructions from the Secretary-General, to refer to letter C.N.282.1979.TREATIES-3 of 7 January 1980 transmitting a copy of the text in English, French and Russian of certain amendments proposed by the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany to annexes 1 and 6 to the Customs Convention on the International Transport of Goods under Cover of TIR Carnets (TIR Convention), concluded at Geneva on 14 November 1975.

I wish to inform you that no objection having been notified to the Secretary-General by 1 July 1980, the amendments in question, in accordance with the decision of the Administrative Committee of 18 October 1979, will enter into force on 1 October 1980.
