ACCEPTANCE OF THE AMENDMENT PROPOSED BY DENMARK  
TO ANNEX 3 TO THE AGREEMENT


Sir,

I have the honour, upon instructions from the Secretary-General, to refer to letter C.N.149.1979.TREATIES-1 of 27 July 1979 communicating the text of an amendment proposed by the Government of Denmark to annex 3 to the Agreement on the International Carriage of Perishable Foodstuffs and on the Special Equipment to be used for such Carriage (ATP) concluded at Geneva on 1 September 1970.

I also wish to refer to letter C.N.19.1980.TREATIES-1 of 21 February 1980 informing you of a notification by the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany made under article 18 (2) (b) of the Agreement.

In this connexion, I wish to inform you that by 28 October 1980, that is to say, on the expiration of a period of nine months following six months from the transmission of the draft amendment, the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany had not notified an objection. Consequently the said amendment has been deemed accepted and, in accordance with paragraph 6 of article 18, it will come into force at the end of a further period of six months, that is to say, on 28 April 1981.
