CONVENTION ON ROAD TRAFFIC  
DONE AT VIENNA ON 8 NOVEMBER 1968

ACCESSION BY URUGUAY

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary of the Convention on Road Traffic, done at Vienna on 8 November 1968, communicates the following:

On 8 April 1981, the instrument of accession by the Government of Uruguay to the above-mentioned Convention was deposited with the Secretary-General.

In a letter accompanying the instrument, the Government of Uruguay declared, in accordance with the respective provisions of articles 45 (4) and 54 (2) of the Convention, that it has selected the letters "ROU" as the distinguishing sign for display in international traffic on vehicles registered by it and that it will treat mopeds as motor cycles for the purposes of the application of the Convention.

In accordance with article 47 (2), the Convention will enter into force for Uruguay twelve months after the date of deposit of its instrument of accession, that is to say, on 8 April 1982.
