UNITED NATIONS CONVENTION ON INTERNATIONAL MULTIMODAL
TRANSPORT OF GOODS
CONCLUDED AT GENEVA ON 24 MAY 1980

TRANSMISSION OF A PROCES-VERBAL OF RECTIFICATION OF THE ARABIC
ORIGINAL OF THE CONVENTION AND OF THE CERTIFIED TRUE COPIES
OF THE CONVENTION ESTABLISHED ON 15 FEBRUARY 1981

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, and referring to depositary notification C.N.64.1982.TREATIES-3 of 31 March 1982 concerning the proposed rectification in respect of the Arabic original of the United Nations Convention on International Multimodal Transport of Goods, concluded at Geneva on 24 May 1980, communicates the following:

Within a period of 90 days from the date of the above-mentioned notification, no objection to the proposed rectification had been received from any of the States concerned. Consequently, the Secretary-General has caused, on 29 June 1982, the appropriate corrections to be effected in the Arabic original of the Convention. A copy of the corresponding Procès-verbal of rectification, which is also applicable to the certified true copies of the Convention established on 15 February 1981 (depositary notification C.N.44.1981. TREATIES-1 of 6 March 1981), is enclosed.
