AGREEMENT ON THE INTERNATIONAL CARRIAGE OF PERISHABLE FOODSTUFFS
AND ON THE SPECIAL EQUIPMENT TO BE USED FOR SUCH CARRIAGE (ATP)
CONCLUDED AT GENEVA ON 1 SEPTEMBER 1970

ACCEPTANCE OF THE AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT
BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND TO ANNEX 1 TO THE AGREEMENT

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, and referring to depositary notification C.N.65.1981.TREATIES-2 of 12 May 1981, by the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland transmitting certain amendments proposed to the Agreement on the International Carriage of Perishable Foodstuffs and on the Special Equipment to be used for such Carriage (ATP), concluded at Geneva on 1 September 1970, communicates the following:

By 13 August 1982, that is to say, on the expiration of a period of nine months following six months from the transmission by the depositary of the proposed amendments, the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany (see depositary notification C.N.201.1981.TREATIES-4 of 14 August 1981) had not notified an objection. Consequently the said amendments have been deemed accepted and, in accordance with article 18 (6), shall enter into force at the end of a further period of six months, that is to say, on 13 February 1983.
