CONVENTION ON THE PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES OF THE SPECIALIZED AGENCIES
APPROVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS
ON 21 NOVEMBER 1947

OBJECTION BY THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND
NORTHERN IRELAND TO THE RESERVATIONS MADE BY HUNGARY UPON APPLICATION
OF THE CONVENTION TO IMF AND IBRD

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, and referring to depositary notification C.N.236.1982. TREATIES-1 of 5 October 1982 concerning the notification by the Government of Hungary that it undertakes to apply the provisions of the Convention to the International Monetary Fund and the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development, communicates the following:

On 21 April 1983, the Secretary-General received from the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland the following objection to the reservations contained in the above-mentioned notification:

(Original: English)

"With regard to the reservations accompanying this undertaking concerning articles 24 and 32 of the Convention (jurisdiction of the International Court of Justice) the Government of the United Kingdom wish to reaffirm the statement in their communication of 5 January 1968 (circulated as C.N.18.1968.TREATIES-1) namely that these reservations are not of a kind which parties to the Convention have the right to make."
