STATUS OF THE CONVENTION AS AT 29 MARCH 1984

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

I

By depositary notification C.N.7.1984.TREATIES-1 of 19 January 1984, the Secretary-General circulated a correction proposed to the original (French text) of the Convention. Within a period of 90 days from the date of the said depositary notification, no objection to the proposed correction had been notified by any of the signatory or contracting States. Consequently, the Secretary-General has caused, on 18 April 1984, the appropriate correction to be effected in the original of the Convention (French text).

A copy of the corresponding Procès-Verbal of rectification, which is also applicable to the certified true copies of the Convention established on 16 March 1983 (depositary notification C.N.156.1983.TREATIES-1 of 7 June 1983) is transmitted herewith.
