ACCEPTANCE OF THE AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY BELGIUM TO ANNEX I
OF THE AGREEMENT

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, and referring to depositary notification C.N.160.1984.TREATIES-3 of 19 July 1984 concerning the amendments proposed by the Government of Belgium to annex I of the above-mentioned Agreement, communicates the following:

By 20 October 1985, that is to say, on the expiry of a period of nine months following the expiry of six months from the transmission by the depositary of the proposed amendments, the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany (see depositary notification C.N.7.1985.TREATIES-1 of 14 February 1985) had not notified an objection. Consequently the said amendments have been deemed accepted and, in accordance with article 18 (6), shall enter into force on 20 April 1986, i.e. six months after the date of acceptance.
