AGREEMENT ON THE INTERNATIONAL CARRIAGE OF PERISHABLE FOODSTUFFS
AND ON THE SPECIAL EQUIPMENT TO BE USED FOR SUCH CARRIAGE (ATP)
CONCLUDED AT GENEVA ON 1 SEPTEMBER 1970

AMENDMENT PROPOSED BY FRANCE TO ANNEX 1 OF THE AGREEMENT:

NOTIFICATIONS BY THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY, ITALY, AND
THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND
UNDER ARTICLE 18 (2) (b) OF THE AGREEMENT

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, and referring to depositary notification C.N.66.1985.TREATIES-2 of 30 July 1985 communicating the text of an amendment proposed by the Government of France to annex 1 of the Agreement, communicates the following:

In communications received on 7, 29 and 30 January 1986, the Governments of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, the Federal Republic of Germany and Italy notified the Secretary-General, pursuant to article 18 (2) (b) of the above-mentioned Agreement, that although they intended to accept the proposal of the Government of France, the conditions necessary for their respective acceptance were not yet fulfilled.

In view of the above, and in accordance with the provisions of paragraphs 2 to 5 of article 18, the proposed amendment will be deemed to have been accepted only if, before the expiry of a period of nine months following the expiry of the period of six months indicated in depositary notification C.N.66.1985.TREATIES-2 of 30 July 1985, i.e., before 31 October 1986, none of the said Governments have notified an objection to the said proposed amendments (unless, of course, all of them notify their acceptance before 31 October 1986, in which case the amendments will be deemed accepted on the date of the latter of such acceptances). The Secretary-General will not fail to inform all States concerned of any development in this respect.
