AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY FRANCE AND THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND TO ANNEX 1 OF THE AGREEMENT

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

In communications received by the Secretary-General respectively on 30 July and 6 August 1987, the Governments of France and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland have proposed certain amendments to annex 1, appendices 1 and 2, of the above-mentioned Agreement, to be communicated to all States concerned in accordance with the procedure set forth in paragraphs 1 to 7 of article 18 of the Agreement.

A copy, in the English and French languages, of the text of the .... proposed amendments is enclosed.

Reference is made in this connexion to the provisions of article 18 (2) of the Agreement, which provide that within a period of six months following the date on which the proposed amendments are communicated by the Secretary-General any Contracting Party may inform the latter (a) that it has an objection to the amendment proposed, or (b) that, although it intends to accept the proposal, the conditions necessary for such acceptance are not yet fulfilled in its country.

If the proposed amendments are deemed to be accepted, they will enter into force in accordance with the provisions of article 18 (6), six months after the date of such acceptance.
