EUROPEAN AGREEMENT ON MAIN INTERNATIONAL
RAILWAY LINES (AGC)
CONCLUDED AT GENEVA ON 31 MAY 1985RATIFICATION BY POLAND

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

On 14 September 1988, the instrument of ratification by the Government of Poland of the above-mentioned Agreement was deposited with the Secretary-General.

The instrument of ratification was accompanied by the following two declarations:

"Poland withdraws its reservation in respect of article 8 of the above-mentioned Agreement made at the time of its signature."
