AGREEMENT ON THE INTERNATIONAL CARRIAGE OF PERISHABLE FOODSTUFFS  
AND ON THE SPECIAL EQUIPMENT TO BE USED FOR SUCH CARRIAGE (ATP)  
CONCLUDED AT GENEVA ON 1 SEPTEMBER 1970

NOTIFICATION BY THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY  
UNDER ARTICLE 18 (2) (b) OF THE AGREEMENT, IN CONNECTION WITH THE  
AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY FRANCE AND THE UNITED KINGDOM OF  
GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND TO ANNEX 1 OF THE AGREEMENT

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, and referring to depositary notification C.N.199.1987.TREATIES-5 of 5 October 1987 and to depositary notification C.N.266.1987.TREATIES-6 of 14 December 1987 (addendum) communicating the text of the amendments proposed by the Governments of France and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to annex 1 of the above-mentioned Agreement, communicates the following:

In a communication received on 28 March 1988, the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany notified the Secretary-General, pursuant to article 18 (2) (b) of the above-mentioned Agreement, that although it intended to accept the proposal of the Governments of France and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, the conditions necessary for such acceptance were not yet fulfilled in respect of the Federal Republic of Germany.

In view of the above, and in accordance with the provisions of paragraphs 2 to 5 of article 18, the proposed amendments will be deemed to have been accepted only if, before the expiry of a period of nine months following the expiry of the period of six months indicated in depositary notification C.N.199.1987.TREATIES-5 of 5 October 1987, i.e. before 6 January 1989, the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany has not notified an objection to the said proposed amendments (unless, of course, the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany notifies its acceptance before 6 January 1989, in which case the amendments will be deemed accepted on the date of such acceptance). The Secretary-General will not fail to inform all States concerned of any development in this respect.
