AGREEMENT ON THE INTERNATIONAL CARRIAGE OF PERISHABLE FOODSTUFFS AND ON THE SPECIAL EQUIPMENT TO BE USED FOR SUCH CARRIAGE (ATP) CONCLUDED AT GENEVA ON 1 SEPTEMBER 1970

### ACCEPTANCE OF THE AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY FRANCE AND THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND TO ANNEX 1 OF THE AGREEMENT

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, and referring to depositary notification C.N.199.1987.TREATIES-5 of 5 October 1987 and to depositary notification C.N.266.1987.TREATIES-6 of 14 December 1987 (addendum) concerning the amendments proposed by the Governments of France and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to annex 1 of the above-mentioned Agreement, communicates the following:

By 6 January 1989, that is to say, on the expiry of a period of nine months following the expiry of six months from the transmission by the depositary of the proposed amendments, the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany (see depositary notification C.N.59.1988.TREATIES-1 of 6 May 1988) had not notified an objection. Consequently the said amendments have been deemed accepted and, in accordance with article 18 (6), shall enter into force on 6 July 1989, i.e. six months after the date of acceptance.
