AGREEMENT ON THE INTERNATIONAL CARRIAGE OF PERISHABLE FOODSTUFFS AND ON THE SPECIAL EQUIPMENT TO BE USED FOR SUCH CARRIAGE (ATP) CONCLUDED AT GENEVA ON 1 SEPTEMBER 1970

### ACCEPTANCE OF THE AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND TO ANNEX 2 OF THE AGREEMENT

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary and with reference to depositary notification C.N.123.1989.TREATIES-2 of 27 June 1989 concerning the amendments proposed by the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to annex 2 of the above-mentioned Agreement, communicates the following:

By 28 September 1990, that is to say, on the expiry of the period of nine months following the expiry of six months from the transmission by the depositary of the proposed amendments, the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany had not notified an objection (see depositary notification C.N.256.1989.TREATIES-5 of 10 November 1989). Consequently, the said amendments have been deemed accepted and, in accordance with article 18 (6), shall enter into force six months after the date on which they were deemed to have been accepted, i.e. on 28 March 1991.
