ACCEPTANCE OF THE AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY SWEDEN TO
ANNEX 1 OF THE AGREEMENT

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary and with reference to depositary notification C.N.165.1989.TREATIES-3 of 14 August 1989, transmitting the text of the amendments proposed by the Government of Sweden to annex 1 of the above-mentioned Agreement, communicates the following:

By 15 November 1990, that is to say, on the expiry of a period of nine months following the expiry of the period of six months from the communication by the depositary of the proposed amendments, the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany (see depositary notification C.N.292.1989.TREATIES-6 of 11 January 1990) had not stated an objection. Consequently, the amendments have been deemed accepted. In accordance with article 18 (6), they shall enter into force six months after the date of such acceptance, i.e. on 15 May 1991.
