AGREEMENT ON THE INTERNATIONAL CARRIAGE OF PERISHABLE FOODSTUFFS AND ON THE SPECIAL EQUIPMENT TO BE USED FOR SUCH CARRIAGE (ATP) CONCLUDED AT GENEVA ON 1 SEPTEMBER 1970

ACCEPTANCE OF THE AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND TO ANNEX I OF THE AGREEMENT:

CORRIGENDUM TO DEPOSITARY NOTIFICATION C.N.252,1990.TREATIES-4 OF 9 NOVEMBER 1990

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, and with reference to depositary notification C.N.9.1990.TREATIES-1 of 12 March 1990 concerning the amendments proposed by the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to annex 1 of the above-mentioned Agreement, communicates the following:

It has now come to our attention that, owing to an administrative oversight, the penultimate and last paragraphs of depositary notification C.N.252.1990.TREATIES-4 of 9 November 1990 were in error. Those paragraphs should therefore be replaced, as follows:

If by 13 June 1991, that is to say, on the expiry of a period of nine months following the expiry of the period of six months from the communication by the depositary of the proposed amendments in said depositary notification C.N.9.1990.TREATIES-1, the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany (see in this regard depositary notification C.N.235.1990.TREATIES-3 of 23 October 1990) has not stated an objection, said amendments will be deemed to have been accepted. In accordance with article 18 (6), they would enter into force six months after the date on which they were deemed to be accepted, i.e. on 13 December 1991.

The Secretary-General will not fail to inform the Contracting Parties, upon the expiration of the above-mentioned delay, of any developments.
