ACCEPTANCE OF THE AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY FRANCE AND THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND TO ANNEX 1 OF THE AGREEMENT

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, and referring to depositary notification C.N.229.1989.TREATIES-4 of 29 September 1989 concerning the amendments proposed by the Governments of France and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to annex 1 of the above-mentioned Agreement, communicates the following:

By 30 March 1990, on the expiry of a period of six months following the date of the above-mentioned depositary notification, none of the Contracting Parties to the Agreement had notified an objection to the said proposed amendments. They have therefore been deemed accepted and, in accordance with article 18 (6), shall enter into force on 30 September 1990, i.e. at the end of a further period of six months.
