CONCLUDED AT GENEVA ON 31 MAY 1985

ACCESSION BY BULGARIA

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

On 9 March 1990, the instrument of accession by the Government of Bulgaria to the above-mentioned Agreement was deposited with the Secretary-General.

In accordance with its article 6 (2), the Agreement will enter into force for Bulgaria on 7 June 1990, i.e. the ninetieth day after the date of the deposit of the said instrument.
