At its ninety-fourth session, the Working Party on the Construction of Vehicles, Principal Working Party on Road Transport, of the Inland Transport Committee of the Economic Commission for Europe adopted certain drafting modifications to the English and French texts of Regulation No. 7 ("Uniform provisions for the approval of front and rear position (side) lamps, stop-lamps and end-outline marker lamps for motor vehicles (except motor cycles) and their trailers") (E/ECE/324-E/ECE/TRANS/505/Add.6/Rev.1/Amend.1) as previously amended.
