EUROPEAN AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE WORK OF CREWS
OF VEHICLES ENGAGED IN INTERNATIONAL
ROAD TRANSPORT (AETR)
DONE AT GENEVA ON 1 JULY 1970ACCEPTANCE OF THE AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY NORWAY

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary and with reference to depositary notification C.N.105.1991.TREATIES-1 of 24 July 1991 concerning the amendments proposed by the Government of Norway to the above-mentioned Agreement, communicates the following:

Within the period of six months following the date of the above-mentioned depositary notification, none of the Contracting Parties to the Agreement expressed an objection. Therefore, in accordance with paragraph 5 (a) of article 23, the proposed amendments are deemed to have been accepted.

Pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 6 of article 23, the amendments to the Agreement will enter into force at the end of a further period of three months, i.e. on 24 April 1992.
