SUCCESSION BY SLOVENIA

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, and in reference to Depositary Letter LA 41 TR/222 SLOVENIA dated 12 October 1992, communicates the following:

On 1 July 1992, the Government of Slovenia notified the Secretary-General that it considered itself bound by the treaties* listed below "by virtue of succession to the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia in respect of the territory of the Republic of Slovenia", with effect from 25 June 1992, the date on which Slovenia assumed responsibility for its international relations:
