CONVENTION ON ROAD TRAFFIC
CONVENTION ON ROAD SIGNS AND SIGNALS
CONCLUDED AT VIENNA ON 8 NOVEMBER 1968

ACCESSION BY ESTONIA

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

On 24 August 1992, the instruments of accession by the Government of Estonia to the above-mentioned Conventions were deposited with the Secretary-General.

I

The instrument in respect of the Convention on Road Traffic, contains the following reservation:

(Original: English)

"... Estonia does not consider itself bound by Article 52 of the Convention."

On depositing its instrument, the Government of Estonia also notified the Secretary-General that:

(Original: English)

"... [In accordance with] Article 45 (4) of the Convention, the Estonian distinguishing sign is 'EW', which belonged to Estonia until its annexation."

II

The instrument in respect of the Convention on Road Signs and Signals, contains the following reservation:

(Original: English)

"... Estonia does not consider itself bound by Article 44 of the Convention."

On depositing its instrument, the Government of Estonia also notified the Secretary-General that:

(Original: English)

"... [In accordance with] Article 46 (2) of the Convention, the Estonian Model danger warning sign is Aa and the Model stop signal is B.2a."

In accordance with their articles 47 (2) and 39 (2), respectively, the Conventions will enter into force for Estonia twelve months after the date of deposit of the instrument, i.e. on 24 August 1993.
