AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY THE NETHERLANDS TO REGULATION NO. 4 ANNEXED TO THE AGREEMENT

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

On 27 January 1992, the Government of the Netherlands proposed, in accordance with article 12, paragraph 1, of the above-mentioned Agreement, several amendments to Regulation No. 4 ("Uniform provisions for the approval of devices for the illumination of rear registration plates of motor vehicles (except motorcycles) and their trailers") annexed to the Agreement.

A copy, in the English and French languages, of the document containing the text of the proposed amendments is transmitted herewith (supplement 4 to Regulation No. 4 in its original form: doc. TRANS/SC1/WP29/290).

In this connexion, the Secretary-General wishes to draw attention to paragraph 1 of article 12 of the said Agreement, which reads as follows:

"Any Contracting Party applying a Regulation may propose one or more amendments to it. The text of any proposed amendment to a Regulation shall be transmitted to the Secretary-General of the United Nations, who shall transmit it to the other Contracting Parties. The amendment shall be deemed to have been accepted unless within a period of three months following this notification a Contracting Party applying the Regulation has expressed an objection, in which case the amendment shall be deemed to have been rejected. If the amendment is deemed to have been accepted, it shall enter into force at the end of a further period of two months."
