CONVENTION ON ROAD TRAFFIC
CONCLUDED AT VIENNA ON 8 NOVEMBER 1968

SUCCESSION BY CROATIA

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

On 23 November 1992, the notification of succession by the Government of Croatia to the above-mentioned Convention was deposited with the Secretary-General, with effect from 8 October 1991, the date on which Croatia assumed responsibility for its international relations.

In pursuance of article 45 (4) of the Convention, the Government of Croatia also notified the Secretary-General that it had selected the distinguishing sign "HR" for display in international traffic on vehicles registered by it.
