AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE ADOPTION OF UNIFORM CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL AND RECIPROCAL RECOGNITION OF APPROVAL FOR MOTOR VEHICLE EQUIPMENT AND PARTS DONE AT GENEVA ON 20 MARCH 1958

APPLICATION OF REGULATIONS NOS. 59 AND 73 BY YUGOSLAVIA

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

On 18 May 1993, the Government of Yugoslavia notified the Secretary-General that it intends to apply Regulations No. 59 and 73 annexed to the above-mentioned Agreement:

Regulation No. 59: Uniform provisions concerning the approval of replacement silencing systems; and

Regulation No. 73: Uniform provisions concerning the approval of goods vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers with regard to their lateral protection

In accordance with article 1 (8) of the Agreement, the Regulations entered into force for Yugoslavia on the sixtieth day after the receipt of the notification, i.e. on 17 July 1993.

The addresses of the national administrative and technical authorities competent for the purposes of this and other Regulations may be obtained from the Transport Division of the Economic Commission for Europe (Palais des Nations, Bureau 334, 1211 Genève 10).
