MULTILATERAL TREATIES DEPOSITED WITH THE SECRETARY-GENERAL  
SUCCESSION BY BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

On 1 September 1993, the Government of Bosnia and Herzegovina notified the Secretary-General that it considered itself bound, "by virtue of succession to the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia in respect of the territory of the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina" by the treaties<sup>1</sup> listed below, as at 6 March 1992, the date on which Bosnia and Herzegovina assumed responsibility for its international relations.

The Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina will apply the Convention only to differences arising out of legal relationships, whether contractual or not, which are considered as commercial under the national law of the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina."
