CONVENTION ON ROAD TRAFFIC
SIGNED AT GENEVA ON 19 SEPTEMBER 1949

SUCCESSION BY NAMIBIA

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

On 13 October 1993, the instrument of succession by the Republic of Namibia to the above-mentioned Convention was deposited with the Secretary-General, with effect from 21 March 1990, the date on which Namibia assumed responsibility for its international relations.

In addition, the Republic of Namibia notified the Secretary-General, in accordance with paragraph 3 of annex 4 of the said Convention, that the distinctive letters "NAM" had been selected as the distinguishing sign of vehicles in international traffic registered in its territory.
