AGREEMENT ON THE INTERNATIONAL CARRIAGE OF PERISHABLE  
FOODSTUFFS AND ON THE SPECIAL EQUIPMENT TO BE USED  
FOR SUCH CARRIAGE (ATP)  
CONCLUDED AT GENEVA ON 1 SEPTEMBER 1970

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY FRANCE TO ANNEX 1 OF THE AGREEMENT

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

On 19 October 1993, the Secretary-General received from the Government of France, in accordance with the procedure set forth in paragraphs 1 to 7 of article 18 of the above-mentioned Agreement, a proposal for amendments to paragraphs 1,2,3,4 and 5 of annex 1, and to paragraph 49 of annex 1, appendix 2, of the Agreement, which read as follows:

(Translation) (Original: French)

1. Amendment to Annex 1, paragraphs 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5

After amendment, the new values for the overall coefficient of heat transfer (K coefficient) should read:

- 0.40 W/m2.K
- 0.70 W/m2.K

2. Amendment to Annex 1, Appendix 2, paragraph 49 of the Agreement

After amendment, the new title of paragraph 49 (a) should read: "Refrigerated equipment other than equipment with fixed eutectic accumulators".

Reference is made in this connection to the terms of article 18 (2) of the Agreement, which provides that:

"Within a period of six months following the date on which the proposed amendment is communicated by the Secretary-General, any Contracting Party may inform the Secretary-General

- (a) that it has an objection to the amendment proposed, or
- (b) that, although it intends to accept the proposal, the conditions necessary for such acceptance are not yet fulfilled in its country."

Any amendment deemed to be accepted under the provisions of article 18 (5) shall enter into force, in accordance with the provisions of article 18 (6), six months after the date on which it was deemed to be accepted.
