CONVENTION ON ROAD TRAFFIC SIGNED AT GENEVA ON 19 SEPTEMBER 1949

ACCESSION BY GEORGIA

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

On 23 July 1993, the instrument of accession by the Government of Georgia to the above-mentioned Convention was deposited with the Secretary-General.

In accordance with its article 29, the Convention entered into force for Georgia on the thirtieth day after the date of deposit of the instrument, i.e. on 22 August 1993.

Subsequently, the Government of Georgia notified the Secretary-General, in pursuance of paragraph 3 of annex 4 to the said Convention, that it had selected the distinguishing sign "GE" for display in international traffic registered by it.
