MULTILATERAL TREATIES DEPOSITED WITH THE SECRETARY-GENERAL
SUCCESSION BY BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

On 12 January 1994, the Government of Bosnia and Herzegovina notified the Secretary-General that Bosnia-Herzegovina considered itself bound, "by virtue of succession to the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia in respect of the territory of the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina" by the treaties¹ listed below, with effect from 6 March 1992, the date on which Bosnia and Herzegovina assumed responsibility for its international relations:
