ACCESSION BY TAJIKISTAN

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

I

On 9 March 1994, the instrument of accession by the Government of Tajikistan to the above-mentioned Convention on Road Traffic was deposited with the Secretary-General.

In accordance with article 45 (4) of the Convention, the Government of Tajikistan has indicated that it has selected the distinguishing sign 'TJ' for display in international traffic on vehicles registered by it.

In accordance with its article 47 (2), the Convention will enter into force for Tajikistan twelve months after the date of deposit of the instrument, i.e. on 9 March 1995.

On 15 March 1994, the Secretary-General received from the Government of Turkmenistan, in accordance with article 45 (4), a notification concerning the decision to replace the distinguishing sign [TMN] chosen by Turkmenistan on its accession in 1993 to the 1968 Convention on Road Traffic with a new distinguishing sign 'TM'.

(In this connexion, reference is made to depositary notification C.N.211.1993.TREATIES-4/1 of 28 August 1993 concerning the accession, on 14 June 1993, by Turkmenistan to the said Convention.)

In accordance with article 54 (4) of the Convention, the modification will take effect three months after the date of receipt of the said notification, i.e. on 15 June 1994.

II

On 9 March 1994, the instrument of accession by the Government of Tajikistan to the above-mentioned Convention on Road Signs and Signals was also deposited with the Secretary-General.

In accordance with its article 39 (2), the Convention will enter into force for Tajikistan twelve months after the date of deposit of the instrument, i.e. on 9 March 1995.
