CONCLUDED AT GENEVA ON 31 MAY 1985

RATIFICATION BY GREECE

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

On 31 March 1995, the instrument of ratification by the Government of Greece to the above Agreement was deposited with the Secretary-General.

In accordance with its article 6 (2), the Agreement will enter into force for Greece on the ninetieth day after the date of deposit of the instrument, i.e. on 29 June 1995.
