OPENED FOR SIGNATURE AT VIENNA ON 8 NOVEMBER 1968
CONCLUDED AT GENEVA ON 1 MARCH 1973

ACCEPTANCE OF THE AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY BELGIUM

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary and with reference to depositary notification C.N.63.1994.TREATIES-1 of 27 May 1994 concerning the amendments proposed by Belgium to the above Protocol, communicates the following:

Within the period of twelve months following the date of the above depositary notification, none of the Contracting Parties expressed an objection to the proposed amendments. Therefore, in accordance with paragraph 2 (a) of article 6 of the Protocol, the proposed amendments are deemed to have been accepted.

Pursuant to the provisions of the said paragraph, the amendments will enter into force at the end of a further period of six months, i.e. on 27 November 1995.
