AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE ADOPTION OF UNIFORM CONDITIONS
OF APPROVAL AND RECIPROCAL RECOGNITION OF APPROVAL
FOR MOTOR VEHICLE EQUIPMENT AND PARTS
DONE AT GENEVA ON 20 MARCH 1958ACCEPTANCE OF THE AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY FRANCE
TO THE ABOVE AGREEMENT

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary and with reference to depositary notification C.N.351.1994.TREATIES-50 of 16 January 1995 transmitting the English and French texts of the amendments proposed by the Government of France to the above Agreement, communicates the following:

By 16 July 1995, i.e. within six months from the date of the above depositary notification, no objection had been notified to the Secretary-General. Consequently, and in accordance with article 13 (3), the said amendments are deemed accepted and will enter into force three months after the expiry of the period of six months, i.e. on 16 October 1995.
