ACCESSION BY MONGOLIA

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

On 19 December 1997, the instruments of accession by the Government of Mongolia to the above Conventions were deposited with the Secretary-General.

In accordance with article 45 (4) of the Convention on Road Traffic, the Government of Mongolia has indicated that it has selected the distinguishing sign "MGL" for display in international traffic on vehicles registered by it.

In accordance with article 46 (2) of the Convention on Road Signs and Signals, the Government of Mongolia has also indicated that it has chosen model A^a as a danger warning sign, and model B2^a as the stop sign.

In accordance with their articles 47 (2) and 39 (2), the above Conventions will enter into force for Mongolia twelve months after the date of deposit of the instruments, i.e. on 19 December 1998.
