GENEVA, 1 SEPTEMBER 1970

ACCEPTANCE OF AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY FRANCE TO ARTICLES 5 AND 10 (1) OF
THE AGREEMENT¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,
communicates the following:

By 30 October 1998, that is to say, on the expiry of a period of nine months following the
expiry of the period of six months following the date on which the proposed amendments were
communicated by the depositary, the Governments of the Netherlands and Germany (see depositary
notifications C.N.34.1998.TREATIES-1 of 18 February 1998 and C.N.797.1998.TREATIES-6 of 21
January 1999) had not submitted any objection. Consequently, the amendments have been deemed
accepted. In accordance with article 18 (6), they shall enter into force six months after the date of
acceptance, i.e., on 30 April 1999.
