ACCEPTANCE OF THE AMENDMENTS PROPOSED TO ANNEXES I, II, III AND IV

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, and with reference to depositary notification C.N.345.1997.TREATIES-2 of 16 September 1997 concerning the amendments proposed to annexes I, II, III and IV of the above Agreement, communicates the following:

By 16 March 1998, that is on the expiry of the period of six months following the date of the above depositary notification, no objection has been received. Consequently, the proposed amendments have been deemed accepted. In accordance with articles 15 (5) and 16 (5), they shall enter into force for all Contracting Parties at the end of a period of three months from the date of this notification, i.e. on 25 June 1998.
