RULE NO. 1. UNIFORM PROVISIONS FOR PERIODICAL TECHNICAL
INSPECTIONS OF WHEELED VEHICLES WITH REGARD TO THE
PROTECTION OF THE ENVIRONMENT

ENTRY INTO FORCE OF RULE NO.1¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,
communicates the following:

Within the period of six months from the date of depositary notification
C.N.532.2001.TREATIES-2 of 4 June 2001 by which the Secretary-General transmitted to the
Governments of the Contracting Parties a copy of the above rule, none of the Contracting Parties to the
Agreement notified its disagreement with the draft rule. Therefore, in accordance with article 2 (1) of
the Agreement, the draft rule has been adopted as Rule No. 1 annexed to the above Agreement. The
date of entry into force for all Contracting Parties is 4 December 2001, pursuant to article 2 (3) of the
Agreement.
