C.N.630.2001.TREATIES-1 of 28 June 2001, none of the Contracting Parties applying Regulation
No. 49 expressed disagreement with the proposed amendments. Therefore, in accordance with
paragraph 2 of article 12 of the Agreement, the proposed amendments are considered to be adopted and
are binding upon all Contracting Parties applying Regulation No. 49 as of 27 December 2001.
