Within the period of six months following the date of depositary notification  
C.N.788.2001.TREATIES-1 of 20 August 2001, none of the Contracting Parties applying Regulation  
No. 13-H expressed disagreement with the proposed amendments. Therefore, in accordance with  
paragraph 2 of article 12 of the Agreement, the proposed amendments are considered to be adopted and  
are binding upon all Contracting Parties applying Regulation No. 13-H as of 20 February 2002.
