ADOPTION OF THE AMENDMENTS PROPOSED TO REGULATION NO. 16  
ANNEXED TO THE AGREEMENT<sup>1</sup>

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,  
communicates the following:

Within the period of six months following the date of depositary notification  
C.N.789.2001.TREATIES-1 of 20 August 2001, none of the Contracting Parties applying Regulation  
No.16 expressed disagreement with the proposed amendments. Therefore, in accordance with  
paragraph 2 of article 12 of the Agreement, the proposed amendments are considered to be adopted and  
are binding upon all Contracting Parties applying Regulation No. 16 as of 20 February 2002, except for  
New Zealand. Pursuant to article 12 (3) of the Agreement, the above amendments will enter into force  
for New Zealand two months after the period of six months following the date of the notification by the  
Secretary-General of the proposed amendments, i.e., 20 April 2002.
