ADOPTION OF AMENDMENTS<sup>1</sup>

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,  
communicates the following:

Within the period of six months following the date of depositary notification  
C.N.165.2002.TREATIES-1 of 26 February 2002, none of the Contracting Parties applying Regulation  
No. 7 expressed disagreement with the proposed amendments. Therefore, in accordance with paragraph  
2 of article 12 of the Agreement, the proposed amendments are considered to be adopted and are  
binding upon all Contracting Parties applying Regulation No. 7 as of 26 August 2002 except Ukraine.  
Pursuant to article 12 (3) of the Agreement, the above amendments will enter into force for Ukraine two  
months after the period of six months following the date of the notification by the Secretary-General of  
the proposed amendments, i.e., 26 October 2002.
