ADOPTION OF AMENDMENTS TO REGULATION NO. 101¹

Regulation No. 101 expressed disagreement with the proposed amendments. Therefore, in accordance
with paragraph 2 of article 12 of the Agreement, the proposed amendments are considered to be adopted
and are binding upon all Contracting Parties applying Regulation No. 101 as of
31 January 2003.
