ENTRY INTO FORCE OF AMENDMENTS TO ANNEX 6 RELATING TO ARTICLE 38,  
PARAGRAPH 1 OF THE CONVENTION<sup>1</sup>

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,  
communicates the following:

By 7 August 2003, none of the Contracting Parties to the above-mentioned Convention had  
communicated an objection to the Secretary-General. Consequently, in accordance with the provisions  
of article 60 (1) of the Convention, the amendments to Annex 6 relating to Article 38, paragraph 1 of the  
Convention will enter into force on 7 November 2003 for all Contracting Parties.
