ENTRY INTO FORCE OF AMENDMENTS TO ANNEX 6 RELATING TO ARTICLE 2,
PARAGRAPH 1(B) OF ANNEX 2 OF THE CONVENTION¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,
communicates the following:

By 7 August 2003, none of the Contracting Parties to the above-mentioned Convention had communicated an objection to the Secretary-General. Consequently, in accordance with the provisions of article 60 (1) of the Convention, the amendments to Annex 6 relating to Article 2, paragraph 1(b) of Annex 2 of the Convention will enter into force on 7 November 2003 for all Contracting Parties.
