Within the period of six months following the date of depositary notification  
C.N.107.2004.TREATIES-1 of 12 February 2004, none of the Contracting Parties applying Regulation  
No. 16 expressed disagreement with the proposed amendments. Therefore, in accordance with  
paragraph 2 of article 12 of the Agreement, the proposed amendments are considered to be adopted and  
are binding upon all Contracting Parties applying Regulation No. 16 as of 12 August 2004.
