CUSTOMS CONVENTION ON THE INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORT OF  
GOODS UNDER COVER OF TIR CARNETS (TIR CONVENTION)

GENEVA, 14 NOVEMBER 1975

PROPOSAL OF AMENDMENTS WITH REGARD TO THE INTRODUCTION  
OF A NEW ARTICLE 42 ter AND THE AMENDMENT OF ARTICLE 60 OF THE CONVENTION,  
TOGETHER WITH THE INTRODUCTION OF A NEW ANNEX 10

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,  
communicates the following:

On 11 May 2005, the Administrative Committee for the 1975 TIR Convention of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) transmitted to the Secretary-General, in accordance with the provisions of article 59 (1) and (2) of the Convention, a proposal of amendments with regard to the introduction of a new Article 42 ter and the amendment of Article 60 of the Convention, together with the introduction of a new Annex 10, adopted at its thirty-eighth session held in Geneva on 3 and 4 February 2005.
